

The Occult Parallel: Lead's Propositions vs. New Apostolic Reformation doctrine

The NAR has sanitized Lead's 17th-century mystical language into modern "apostolic" terminology, but the core "Luciferian" impulse remains: the transition of the Church from a body of redeemed sinners to a race of "divinized" masters.

1. The "New Breed" of Immortal Humans

- Jane Lead (Prop. 5 & 18): Lead prophesied the rise of a "Virgin Church" composed of individuals who have reached a state of "perfection" and "immortality" while still in their physical bodies.
- The NAR (Manifest Sons of God): This is the direct ancestor of the Manifest Sons of God doctrine. Leaders like Bill Hamon and the late Paul Cain have long taught that an "end-time generation" will overcome death and become the "incarnate Word" on earth.
- The Occult Link: This is the Gnostic Alchemical Great Work—the transmutation of the human into the divine.

2. The Restoration of the "Melchizedek" Priesthood

- Jane Lead (Prop. 13-15): She spoke of a coming "Melchizedek Priesthood" that would possess "magical" power over the elements and creation, operating in "transfigured" bodies.
- The NAR (Apostolic Governance): The NAR claims that "Apostles" are currently being restored to the earth to function in this Melchizedek authority, possessing "Kingdom keys" to unlock wealth and control the "Seven Mountains."
- The Occult Link: This aligns with Alice Bailey's "Externalisation of the Hierarchy," where "Masters of Wisdom" (the Melchizedek Order in occultism) take control of the physical world.

3. The "Philadelphian" Elite vs. The "Laodicean" Church

- Jane Lead (Prop. 21-24): Lead taught that the traditional church (the "outer court") would be superseded by the "Philadelphian Church" (the "inner court" of initiates).
- The NAR (The New Wineskin): The NAR frequently teaches that those who cling to traditional doctrine have a "Religious Spirit" (Laodicean) and must be bypassed by those who have the "New Revelation" (Philadelphian).
- The Occult Link: This is the Theosophical concept of the "Root Races" or the "Group of World Servers" who are "spiritually evolved" compared to the rest of humanity.

The "Sixty Propositions" as a Blueprint for Dominion

In Lead's propositions, we see the earliest seeds of Postmillennialism and Kingdom Now theology—the belief that the Church must conquer the earth *before* Christ can return.

Why This Matters: The Luciferian "Golden Age"

Jane Lead's "Sixty Propositions" were steeped in the Boehmenist tradition (Jacob Boehme), which is a blend of Christian mysticism and Hermetic alchemy. When the NAR cites Lead (often through the "Latter Rain" teachers), they are re-introducing Hermeticism into the Church.

The "Golden Age" Lead predicted is identical to the Age of Aquarius. It is a time when "Man" becomes the "Christ" and the external Savior (Jesus) is no longer needed because the "Corporate Christ" has emerged.

The Warning: By following the "Sixty Propositions," the NAR is not leading the Church into a revival; it is leading the Church into the "great falling away" (2 Thessalonians 2:3). It is the transition from a Church that *waits* for her King to a Church that *replaces* her King with her own "Apostolic" divinity.

This isn't a 21st-century move of God, but a 17th-century occult seedling that has finally matured into a global Trojan Horse.

The Verbal Overlap: Jane Lead vs. The Modern Apostles

The following table compares Lead's 1697 *Sixty Propositions* with the rhetoric found in the writings of prominent NAR and Latter Rain figures. Notice how the "immortality of the saints" and "dominion over the earth" are the consistent themes.

This side-by-side comparison is the "smoking gun." It demonstrates that the NAR is not offering a "fresh move of God," but is instead recycling the Philadelphian mysticism of Jane Lead—a system that replaces the finished work of Jesus with the ongoing "evolution" of an elite class of believers.

Analyzing the Deception

1. The Death of the "Individual" for the "Corporate"

Lead's focus on the "Holy Seed" and the NAR's focus on the "Corporate Christ" both seek to dissolve the individual's relationship with a personal Savior into a collective, mystical entity. In the New Age, this is called Global Consciousness. In the NAR, it is called the One New Man or Corporate Anointing.

2. The "Sophia" Influence

Jane Lead's obsession with "Virgin Wisdom" (Sophia) is a direct import from Gnosticism. It suggests that the written Word is insufficient and that we need a "feminine," intuitive, "right-brain" revelation to reach perfection. This is why the NAR prioritizes "prophetic downloads" over historical exegesis.

3. The Transmutation of the Gospel

Notice that in both Lead's propositions and NAR quotes, the Cross is missing.

- **The Biblical Gospel: Salvation through the blood of Jesus for the forgiveness of sins.**
- **The Lead/NAR "Gospel": Evolution through "activation" and "alignment" to achieve dominion and immortality.**
